### Resilient Coders (February 2023 - Present)

**Find Me Food:** developed a cross-platform application using API data to connect marginalized communities to affordable food options and combat food deserts.

**Mood Board Generator API:** created a mood board using API integration after exploring several ideas; used the API to generate an artist's bio and images based on the artist's name as well.

**Seven Wonders API:** created an API that allowed user to enter a continent and receive seven of its 'wonders,' natural, cultural, architectural, and engineering.
